2019 BUDGET WORKSHOP MEETING

The Budget Workshop Meeting of the Leet Township Board of Commissioners was brought to order at 6 p.m. by President Gary Bradel in the Leet Township Municipal Building, 198 Ambridge Ave., Fair Oaks, PA 15003. Commissioners present were Jeff Besong, Jim Janaszek, Donna Adipietro and Gary Bradel.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

MOTION: Mr. Janaszek made a motion to go into Executive Session to discuss police employee issues, seconded by Mrs. Adipietro, with all in favor.

MOTION: Mr. Janaszek made a motion to come out of Executive Session after police discussing police employee issues, seconded by Mrs. Adipietro, with all in favor.

MOTION: Mr. Janaszek made a motion to extend Robert Simmons a retirement offer, as discussed, seconded by Mrs. Adipietro. Mr. Janaszek, Mrs. Adipietro and Mr. Bradel were in favor of. Mr. Besong was opposed.

MOTION: Mr. Janaszek made a motion to appoint Michael Molinaro to the position of Captain with a 5% increase effective as of the next pay period, seconded by Mrs. Adipietro, with all in favor.

MOTION: Mr. Janaszek made a motion to appoint Ron Wilson to the position of Officer in Charge, with no increase for 1 year, seconded by Mrs. Adipietro, with all in favor.

BUDGET DISCUSSION

Ms. Rengers presented a draft of the Budget. No increase is proposed, and mills will remain at 7.7. Many of the Budget numbers are like last year's numbers. Numbers have been added for paving in Olde Sewickley Highlands and Capitol Reserve accounts. The Board was pleased with the Budget.

BID FOR SMOKE DETECTORS

MOTION: Mr. Janaszek made a motion to approve a bid from Knighthawk, in the amount of \$1,223.00, for the installation of smoke detectors and a monitoring system at 194 Ambridge Ave., seconded by Mr. Besong, with all in favor.
