

**LEET TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY**  
**RESOLUTION NO. 1 OF 2025**

A RESOLUTION OF THE LEET TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY PROVIDING FOR THE CHANGE OF RETAIL FEES/ RATES FOR PROVIDING SANITARY SEWAGE SERVICE TO CUSTOMERS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE MUNICIPALITY AUTHORITIES ACT AND FURTHER PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF SAID RATES.

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WHEREAS, the LEET Township MUNICIPAL Authority (the "Authority") is a body corporate and politic, organized and existing under the Municipality Authorities Act of 2001 as amended (the "Act"), and maintaining its principal place of business at 194 Ambridge Avenue, Fair Oaks, PA 15003 in the County of Allegheny, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the Authority is authorized by the Act to, "fix, alter, charge, and collect rates and other charges in the area served by its facilities at reasonable and uniform rates to be determined exclusively by it, for the purpose of providing for the payment of the expenses of the Authority, the construction, improvement, repair, maintenance, and operation of its facilities and properties..."; and

WHEREAS, the complete schedule of Rates for Sewerage Service was originally adopted by the Township of Leet, effective January 1, 1962, under Ordinance Number 123, as subsequently amended from time to time as authorized by the Act; and

WHEREAS, the fees charged for providing sanitary sewer service is based on a duly adopted schedule in effect at the time that service is provided; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has entered into an Agreement with the Borough of Ambridge Municipal Authority ("BAMA"), and amendments thereto, providing for the rendering of sewage treatment service by BAMA to the Authority; and

WHEREAS, on December 17, 2024, the Authority was notified by BAMA of BAMA's intention to increase sewage treatment rates, effective April 1, 2025, pursuant to BAMA Resolution No. 1 of December 16, 2024; and

WHEREAS, in anticipation of the pending increase in treatment and other operating expenses, the Authority directed its consulting engineer, Bankson Engineers, Inc., to review the Authority's current rate structure; and

WHEREAS, the Authority, at a public meeting held on June 2, 2025, discussed and considered rate recommendations for new rates to meet the costs associated with the increased sewage treatment rate imposed by BAMA and other operating costs, as presented by the Authority's Consulting Engineer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and the LEET TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY does hereby resolve as follows:

1. The schedule for retail rates for Authority customers shall be adopted in accordance with the attached Exhibit A, which is made an integral part of this resolution.

2. The effective date of Resolution No. 1 of 2025 shall be July 1, 2025.
3. All the provisions of the Authority's Rules and Regulations, currently in effect, and as subsequently amended, not inconsistent herewith shall remain in full force and effect.
